

CHILD & ADOLESCENT SERVICES

The Teen Center is a non-recreational 'drop-in' outreach program located at Oxford Valley Mall. Staff provide information and referrals, short term and crisis counseling, and psycho-social education on a variety of topics unique to teens.

Families and Schools Together (F.A.S.T) is a research-based program that strengthens parent-child relationships, encourages networking, and helps families feel more comfortable in their dealings with school and other community resources.

Parents As Teachers (PAT) is an early childhood parent education and family support program serving families from pregnancy until their child enters kindergarten.

LINKS is a time-limited family reunification services program. It is designed to respond quickly when a child is placed in foster care with a range of services that rebuild parent-child connections while preparing parents to assume full-time responsibility of their children.

ADULT SERVICES

Parent Support Group (A Pennsylvania Family Support Alliance Affiliate) is a weekly group for parents seeking to improve their parenting abilities by learning effective discipline and ways to reduce stress.

Ways to Work offers low interest loans to families who are struggling to become economically self-sufficient, making it possible for parents who have no, or a blemished, credit history to borrow money from local banks to purchase or repair used cars.

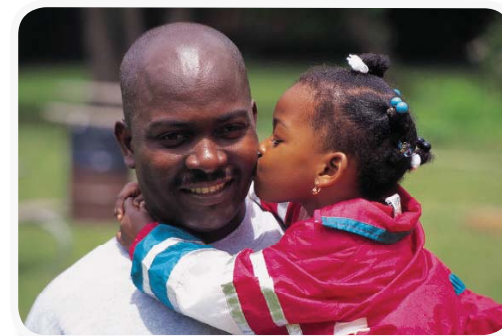

BEHAVIORAL HEALTH

Outpatient Therapy is the core program of Family Service Association. We are committed to providing the best counseling and psychiatric/medication consultations to individuals, couples, families, and groups of all ages from all cultural and socioeconomic backgrounds.

Supportive Case-management Outreach Team (SCOT) assists people with diagnosed mental health and/or substance abuse related disorders who need assistance to achieve their recovery goals. SCOT helps people manage their illness, so they can maintain a consistent level of psychiatric stability, reduce substance abuse, and achieve a higher level of functioning in their community.

Wellness & Tobacco Dependency Program

Through personalized assessments and groups, our nursing staff and Certified Tobacco Specialists help clients in Outpatient Therapy manage weight and wellness, and to take steps to quit smoking.

School-based Services provide counseling, and drug & alcohol abuse prevention education to children and their parents in local schools. The School Outreach Program helps middle school children of immigrant families in Bristol Township.



HIV/AIDS SERVICES

Medical Case Management services provide a continuum of care that includes prevention education, dental care, mental health and psychiatric care, transportation, food and nutrition, volunteer support and emergency financial assistance.

Healthy Relationships This nationally recognized prevention program is designed to reduce participants' stress related to safer sexual behaviors and disclosure of their serostatus to family, friends, and sex partners. A certified peer educator tailors presentations, workshops and trainings to help those who are HIV+ learn problem-solving and decision-making skills to address coping with stress related to safer sexual behaviors and disclosure of serostatus.

Bucks CARES (Bucks Consortium for AIDS Risk-reduction Education and Services) provides HIV/AIDS education at 10 substance abuse treatment facilities and Bucks County Correctional facilities.

Bucks Villa, Inc. is a group home with supportive services for persons disabled by HIV/AIDS. FSA is the Management Agent for Bucks Villa, Inc.

Care Outreach is a program helping anyone who is HIV+ and not receiving treatment to get connected with medical care, mental health services and other support services. This service is for those who are newly diagnosed as well as for those who have not been to an infectious disease doctor in over three months.

OLDER ADULT SERVICES

Care Management and Counseling assesses problems, identify options and resources, and addresses emotional problems of older adults or the family members caring for them.

Guardianship reaches out to older adults who lack the capacity to make personal decisions for themselves, and have no friends or family who can act in that capacity. As a Guardian, Case Managers strive to make sure each person receives good quality care and that the Ward's basic needs of food, shelter, personal and medical care are met. We do this by working closely with lawyers, physicians, nurses, therapists and others to plan the best possible course of treatment and care.

Bucks County Housing Authority Case Management serves senior residents currently residing in one of nine of Bucks County Housing Authority managed housing sites. Services help seniors whose ability to maintain independent living is in question.



COMMUNITY BUILDING INITIATIVES
