

FAMILY STRENGTHENING PROGRAMS

AACES (Asperger's Awareness, Community Education, and Support) program is designed to increase independence and decrease isolation among young adults with Asperger's. Each component of AACES supports the transition of young adults, 18-26 years with Asperger's Syndrome and/or PDD/NOS, into adulthood.

Parents As Teachers (PAT) is an early childhood parent education and family support program serving families from pregnancy until their child enters kindergarten.

LINKS is a time-limited family reunification services program. It is designed to respond quickly when a child is placed in foster care with a range of services that rebuild parent-child connections while preparing parents to assume full-time responsibility of their children.

Parent Support Group (A Pennsylvania Family Support Alliance Affiliate) is a weekly group for parents seeking to improve their parenting abilities by learning effective discipline and ways to reduce stress.

Ways to Work offers low interest loans to families who are struggling to become economically self-sufficient, making it possible for parents who have no, or a blemished, credit history to borrow money from local banks to purchase or repair used cars.

THE TEEN CENTER

The Teen Center is a non-recreational 'drop-in' outreach program located at Oxford Valley Mall. Staff provide information and referrals, short term and crisis counseling, and psycho-social education on a variety of topics unique to teens.

BEHAVIORAL HEALTH

Outpatient Therapy is the core program of Family Service Association. Because we take a holistic approach to mental health treatment we also provide psychiatric and nursing services, medication education, group therapy, tobacco dependency services, and case management, all in a highly confidential manner. Services are provided in our various offices, in schools throughout Bucks County and in the homeless shelter. We work with your support systems— family, school, primary care physicians—to provide the best treatment for your personal needs.

Supportive Case-management Outreach Team (SCOT) assists people with diagnosed mental health and/or substance abuse related disorders to achieve their recovery goals. SCOT helps people manage their illness, so they can maintain a consistent level of psychiatric stability, reduce substance abuse, and achieve a higher level of functioning in their community.

Tobacco Dependency Program

Through personalized assessments and groups, our nursing staff and Certified Tobacco Specialists help clients in Outpatient Therapy to take steps to quit smoking and lead healthier lives.



HIV/AIDS SERVICES

Medical Case Management services provide a continuum of care that includes connection to medical services, prevention education, dental care, mental health and psychiatric care, transportation, food and nutrition, and emergency financial assistance.

Bucks CARES (Bucks Consortium for AIDS Risk-reduction Education and Services) provides HIV/AIDS education at substance abuse treatment facilities and Bucks County Correctional facilities.

Care Outreach connects people newly diagnosed with HIV and those who have not been to an infectious disease doctor in over three months, to medical care, mental health services and other support services.

BUCKS VILLA, Inc.

Bucks Villa is a group home for people who are HIV positive or living with AIDS. It is managed by Family Service Association of Bucks County. Bucks Villa, Inc. is an equal opportunity housing provider. Business is conducted in accordance with the Federal Fair Housing Law. Services and employment are provided without regard to race, color, creed, ancestry, national origin, age, sex, handicap or sexual orientation.

KELLY FAMILY CENTER

The Kelly Family Center provides a seamless, comprehensive and easily accessed network of services for children and families all over Bucks County. Services promote positive child development, encourage economic self-sufficiency, and assure healthy development of children. All services support and preserve the family unit as the foundation for success for children.

OLDER ADULT SERVICES

Care Management and Counseling assesses problems, identify options and resources, and addresses emotional problems of older adults or the family members caring for them.

Bucks County Housing Authority Case Management serves senior residents currently residing in one of nine of Bucks County Housing Authority managed housing sites. Services help seniors whose ability to maintain independent living is in question.
