# FREE Prescription Drug Discount Cards

## Save 30% or more • \$20 per prescription

Together, with very little effort, and no cost, we can reduce the cost of medicine by an average of 30% or more.

We know it may sound too good to be true, but it's not. 95% of the pharmacies nationwide have agreed to provide lower pricing to everyone that brings in a FamilyWize prescription drug discount card. All we have to do is get one of these cards to everyone we can.

We are asking every organization and agency possible to help. Please distribute these free FamilyWize cards to as many people as you can throughout the community (and around the country). We will provide you with as many cards as you can distribute.

### WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

- Average Discount = 30% or more - \$20 per prescription.
- Accepted at most pharmacies nationwide, including all major chains.
- Covers all prescription drugs.
- Covers everyone with no health insurance or prescription coverage.
- All cards are bi-lingual, in English and Spanish.
- Covers all medicine not covered by insurance, Medicaid, Medicare or other benefit plans
- No age, income or residency restrictions. Anyone can use it.
- No registration, activation, paperwork or enrollment. No personal information is collected.
- No cost to the United Way, your organization or people using the cards.

### HOW IT'S FUNDED

The savings on the cost of the medicine is provided by the pharmacies. They have agreed to accept prices for medications that are close to the prices they make available to large insurance companies and employers. All other program costs are provided by in-kind donations from the program sponsors and by part of the processing fee included in the cost of the medicine. ### ABOUT FAMILYWIZE

40% of people in the United States in the last two years have either skipped filling a prescription or reduced doses because the medicine was too expensive. To address this, more than 900 United Way agencies and America's Promise Alliance Partners, in all 50 states, have come together in this FamilyWize community service partnership to organize and coordinate community-wide distribution of these free prescription drug discount cards. ## THE UNINSURED AND UNDERINSURED

**UNINSURED** - ANYONE without health insurance or Medicaid/Medicare/Veterans Benefits

- **INDIVIDUALS AND FAMILIES**
  - Parents whose children qualify for SCHIP (State Children's Health Insurance Program) but who don't qualify for any assistance for themselves
  - College age children - or children living at home who are no longer covered due to age
  - Family members not covered by employer-provided health insurance
- **EMPLOYEES**
  - Employees of small businesses that don't offer insurance
  - Employees who can't afford their share of the insurance premium or decline coverage
  - Part-time or minimum wage employees
  - Laid off employees who can't/don't take advantage of COBRA

**UNDERINSURED** – ANYONE whose medications are not covered by their plan

- **INDIVIDUALS AND FAMILIES**
  - Who have deductibles and waiting periods
  - Whose plan does not include prescription coverage
  - Whose medication is not covered by their plan
  - Whose co-pay is higher than the discounted FamilyWize price
  - Whose plan is limited or only covers catastrophic coverage
- **EMPLOYEES**
  - In deductible or in waiting periods before they are eligible
  - Employees who take medications that are not covered by their insurance plan
- **PEOPLE IN THE "MEDICARE DONUT HOLE"**
  - Medicare recipients without a Medicare Part D Prescription plan
  - Medicare Part D Prescription Plan enrollees without "Medi-Gap"
