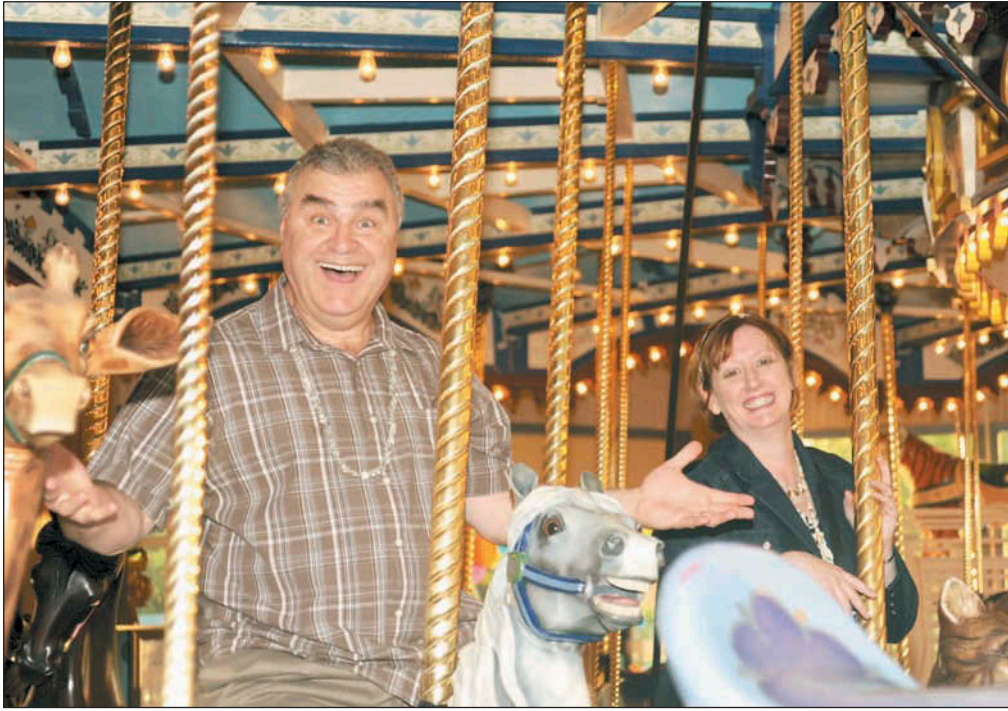


Cruise the Village raises more than \$28,000 for FSA
