You have helped Caroline--just one child of hundreds who come to us for help each year.



And then, a few days later with Caroline and her sister watching, their father was taken away to jail for possession of drugs.

In less than a week, Caroline's whole world ceased to exist as she knew it. For years, Caroline seemed to cope with the trauma, but a few months ago Caroline became withdrawn, quiet, and sad. When Caroline starting have problems at school, the school counselor referred her to Family Service.

Through counseling, Caroline, now eleven, is learning to process her grief and her guilt. She is opening up and healing. Things are better at school.

Many youth are struggling with increased stress within their homes as their parents face job losses, financial difficulties and other problems. Thanks to you, Family Service is here to help them.

YOUNG CHAMPIONS

Michelle came to our attention because of her generosity at her 16th birthday a few years back. Instead of accepting presents, she asked her friends to contribute towards prom arrangements for Chelsea, a young woman with Down Syndrome. Because of Michelle's selflessness, Chelsea wore a beautiful gown and had her hair done—things her family just were not able to provide at the time.

“Giving” seems to come naturally to Michelle. As a Pennsbury High School cheerleader, she helped with collections for our troops and area families in need. Michelle also brought her cheerleading team to cheer for the athletes with special needs in the Bucks County Challenger football program this past Fall. Michelle has been an active member of the PHS chapter of the National Honor Society and involved in their many projects for charities which the students select. Michelle has been a volunteer for the Special Olympics, Friendship Circle and the annual walk for Autism Awareness.

Michelle is a devoted sister to her younger brother, Matt, who has autism. She gives time to him every day and takes pride in teaching him skills both fun and necessary to make him successful. This is one of the reasons she selected a college close to home so that she can see him regularly and remain an intrinsic part of his life. Michelle is graduating from Pennsbury High School with honors this week and will be attending Temple University in Philadelphia, majoring in Sports Management.

Kimberly Wodzanowski

Kimmie has made a significant impact on our community, and specifically on the students in the Pennsbury School District, with a highly successful recycling project. Kimmie started the project to fulfill the requirements of the Girl Scout Gold Award. While the Pennsbury School District had recycling in place, Kimmie noticed that many of the students were not using the bins provided. Kimmie educated her fellow students regarding the value of recycling; and also gathered a team of students to collect recyclable bottles at the high school home football games. Kimmie then applied for grants in order to place proper containers at the high school field as well as at the middle school fields. Also, during the recent four days of District testing, Kimmie made sure that over 4,000 bottles were collected by a team of youth volunteers.

Because of her efforts, Kimmie has raised the awareness of recycling in the eyes of local children, adults and government. Although one of the Gold Award requirements is to put in 100 hours of effort, Kimmie has well surpassed 100 hours—and she intends to continue, and expand it, next school year!

In addition to this project, Kimmie has volunteered for several years at a local Girl Scout Camp; this year she has taken on even more of a leadership role in the year-long planning of the camp. Kimmie is also a certified soccer referee for both the YMS and Falls Township leagues. She especially enjoys being a youth referee, because she can not only make the calls but more importantly explain the rules to the children as they play. Kimmie is finishing her sophomore year at Pennsbury High School this week, where she plays percussion in the band.


