Volunteer Opportunities

CONTACT HELPLINE LISTENER

Answer telephone calls from individuals with a wide range of needs including family and mental health issues, financial concerns or simply the need for someone to listen. *Training, continuing education and supervision are provided. Shifts available from 8:00 AM to 8:00 PM, 7 days a week.*



HOUSING LINK ASSISTANT

Respond to calls from individuals throughout Bucks County who are experiencing challenges with housing. Gather information in order to refer callers to the closest and most appropriate resource. *Training provided. Shifts available from 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM, Monday through Thursday.*

KITCHEN ASSISTANT

Help prepare and serve meals for homeless shelter residents, and assist with clean-up afterwards. A hair net, gloves and closed-toe shoes are required. *Shifts are 10:30 AM to 12:00 PM or 4:00 PM to 6:00 PM.*

OFFICE ASSISTANT

Assist with a variety of administrative needs including data entry, filing and mailings. Choose to float among various programs or work with the same program each week. *Varied schedules.*

PANTRY ATTENDANT

Receive and sort food and other donations at the Bucks County Emergency Homeless Shelter, keeping the pantry area clean and well organized. *Flexible schedule.*

SOCIAL COACH

Help teens and young adults practice social skills by engaging in conversations and playing games. *Wednesday or Thursday afternoons/evenings.*



How to Volunteer

1. Complete our application online at www.fsabc.org/volunteer.
2. We will contact you to schedule a convenient time to meet with our Director of Volunteer Services.
3. Provide us with a copy of your Pennsylvania Criminal Record Check.
4. Complete orientation.
5. Register for training (CONTACT Helpline Listeners, Housing Link and Kitchen Assistants only).

Shelter volunteers must provide a copy of a PA Child Abuse Clearance dated within the last twelve months and documentation of a flu vaccine if you are joining us during flu season.

Shelter and CONTACT volunteers must complete training in recognizing and reporting child abuse.
