



CARE COORDINATION FOR OPIOID USE DISORDERS

Family Service's Care Coordination program was developed in response to the growing opioid abuse epidemic. We believe in recovery and will help you get your life back on track.

Our Care Coordinators are community based and can meet you at your location of choice. Our team consists of Counselors, Recovery Specialists, Recovery Coaches and a Nurse who will work with you to access the behavioral and physical health services you need, and who will stay with you to support your recovery.

WHAT WE DO

- Provide support as you transition from one treatment provider or level of care to another
- Help connect you to treatment, supports and resources that you need most
- Work with your other treatment providers and supports to coordinate care
- Help you access Medication Assisted Treatment if indicated
- Assist you with attaining insurance, finding supportive housing and addressing other life needs
- Support you in achieving your goals



WHO IS ELIGIBLE

We serve adults, ages 18 and older, who have an Opioid Use Disorder or who are actively using opioids. Our services are for those who have or are eligible for Medicaid.
