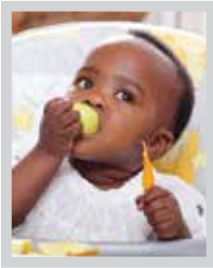

CHILDREN'S GREATEST NEEDS SPONSOR: \$15,000

The needs of our community change over time, and Family Service prides itself on being able to adapt to meet those ever-changing needs. \$15,000 can help Family Service continue to meet the most urgent needs facing children and families in our community.

SUICIDE PREVENTION SPONSOR: \$10,000

Suicide is the 3rd leading cause of death for youth ages 11-24. In Bucks County, it's the 2nd leading cause of death for this age group. We prevent suicide by answering calls for help on our CONTACT Helpline and the National Suicide Prevention Lifeline. \$10,000 can provide 10 weeks of supervised training for volunteer listeners so they are adequately prepared to answer calls from suicidal teens.

EMERGENCY SHELTER SPONSOR: \$7,500

Approximately 500 people are homeless in Bucks County, and about 40% of those are children. We provide emergency shelter, case management, transportation and a variety of other services for individuals and families who have lost safe, stable housing. \$5,000 can provide 3 meals a day for 6 weeks for all 70 people who are temporarily residing at the shelter.

SCHOOL-BASED COUNSELING SPONSOR: \$5,000

Fewer than 20% of children and adolescents with diagnosable mental health problems receive the treatment they need. We eliminate many barriers that can prevent families from accessing mental health services for children by providing counseling directly in the school environment. \$5,000 can provide 100 hours of counseling for children.

JOB DEVELOPMENT SPONSOR: \$2,500

Young adults with disabilities are less likely to have jobs after high school than peers without a disability. We help young adults with disabilities gain and maintain competitive employment by helping develop resumes, building interview skills and providing job coaching services. \$2,500 can provide 50 hours of job development and coaching for a young adult with a disability.

FAMILY REUNIFICATION SPONSOR: \$1,000

More than 350 Bucks County children live in foster homes. We work with parents to reunify families within the first 15 months of a child being placed in foster care. \$1,000 can provide 20 hours of case management services to help reunify children in foster care with their parents.

PARENT EDUCATION SPONSOR: \$500

1 in 10 children suffer from child maltreatment. The youngest children are the most vulnerable; over 45% of abused children are under the age of 5. We prevent child abuse by educating parents and providing early child services. \$500 can provide 20 hours of in-home parent education, counseling and case management services designed to build nurturing skills as alternatives to negative parenting attitudes and practices.

TEEN SUPPORT SPONSOR: \$250

1 in 12 teens ages 13-18 has an anxiety disorder; of those, only 18% receive mental health care. We provide teens with a confidential place where they can talk about problems and get support from caring professionals and others who are going through similar struggles. \$250 can provide professional facilitators for a group discussion on a topic such as anger management, depression and anxiety, substance abuse or family conflict.
