Children's Greatest Needs Sponsor: \$15,000

The needs of our community change over time, and we pride ourselves on being able to adapt to meet those ever-changing needs. \$15,000 will help us continue to meet the most urgent needs facing children and families in our community. *Benefits include 2 foursomes, a full page program ad, a banner at event, logo on tee sign, recognition at banquet and in press release, website link*

Suicide Prevention Sponsor: \$10,000

We prevent suicide by answering calls for help on our CONTACT Helpline and the National Suicide Prevention Lifeline. \$10,000 could provide 10 weeks of training for volunteers so they are adequately prepared to answer calls. *Benefits: 2 foursomes, full page program ad, logo on tee sign, recognition at banquet and in press release, website link*

Emergency Shelter Sponsor: \$7,500

We provide emergency shelter, case management, transportation and a variety of other services for individuals and families who have lost safe, stable housing. \$7,500 could provide 3 meals a day for 6 weeks for all 75 people who are temporarily residing at the shelter. *Benefits: 1 foursome, full page program ad, logo on tee sign, recognition at banquet and in press release, website link*

School-Based Counseling Sponsor: \$5,000

We eliminate many barriers that can prevent families from accessing mental health services for children by providing counseling directly in the school environment. \$5,000 could provide 100 hours of counseling for children. *Benefits: 2 golfers, full page program ad, logo on tee sign, recognition at banquet and in press release, website listing*



Job Development Sponsor: \$2,500

We help young adults with disabilities gain and maintain competitive employment by helping develop resumes, building interview skills and providing job coaching services. \$2,500 could provide 50 hours of job development and coaching for a young adult with a disability. *Benefits: Full page program ad, logo on tee sign, recognition at banquet and in press release, website listing*

Family Reunification Sponsor: \$1,000

We work with parents to reunify families within the first 15 months of a child being placed in foster care. \$1,000 could provide 20 hours of case management services to help reunify children in foster care with their parents. *Benefits: Half page program ad, logo on tee sign, recognition at banquet and in press release, website listing*

Parent Education Sponsor: \$500

We prevent child abuse by educating parents and providing early child services. \$500 could provide 20 hours of in-home parent education and case management services designed to build nurturing skills as alternatives to negative parenting attitudes and practices. *Benefits: Quarter page program ad, logo on tee sign, recognition at banquet, website listing*

Teen Support Sponsor: \$250
