School-Based Counseling

Services for Children in their School Environment

Many families have difficulties attending a traditional outpatient clinic. School-based services enable children to receive counseling directly in the school they attend each day.

Our clinicians, your child's teachers and other support staff communicate directly in order to effectively coordinate care. We work closely with your child's school to maximize the benefits from counseling. Family counseling is also provided and encouraged. Parents are required to be a part of treatment planning.



Our Staff

Licensed professional counselors, licensed clinical social workers and masters-level therapists provide on-site counseling and therapy services during regular school hours.

Special arrangements can be made with individual therapists to schedule appointments during after school hours for parents and caregivers who are not available during the day.

Confidentiality

Services are strictly confidential and adhere to Pennsylvania Mental Health and Drug and Alcohol licensing regulations and HIPPA regulations. Private information will be shared only upon written authorization.

Psychiatry Services

Sometimes children require medication to assist in managing behaviors or mood. Child psychiatrists are available in our Langhorne, Doylestown and Quakertown offices to provide consultation or medication management.



Eligibility

Any child with Medical Assistance in a partner school is eligible for this service.

Fees & Insurance

Medical Assistance covers the full cost of in-school counseling services for your child. Unfortunately, commercial insurance is not accepted at this time in our school-based program.
