

# COVID-19 Creates Need for Dual Shelter/Hotel Model

The Bucks County Emergency Homeless Shelter, a program of Family Service, is a temporary residence for individuals and families who have lost safe and stable housing. The shelter operates 24 hours a day, 365 days a year and accommodates approximately 75 people at any given time. Typically, about a third of the residents are children.

On-site services for shelter residents include case management, job search and preparation, budget planning, health evaluations and referrals, outpatient counseling, and transportation.

The number of people needing shelter has gone up during the coronavirus pandemic. With our waitlist growing and to better meet our community's emergency shelter needs, we began leasing rooms at a local hotel to spread out clients for social distancing. While not ideal for delivery of services, staff and residents have adapted to this dual shelter/hotel model for the safety of all involved.

Despite these changes in service delivery, contributions from generous donors and the incredible effort put forth by hundreds of hard-working volunteers each year remain the driving force behind the shelter's sustainability.
